



## **Editorial Committee Minutes: 13 January 2022**

**Attendance:** John Dumford (Chair), Charlotte Dumford (Board Liaison), Dr. Rosanne Palermo, Angie DePuydt, Jason Tice, Dr. Kirk Steehler, Annette Carpenter, Lori Ann Thwing.

Mr. Dumford informed the committee that the FHANA Resource Book is completed, printed, and delivered to the FHANA office.

Mr. Tice reported that 150 boxes of Resource Books has been delivered. The committee discussed sending copies of the Resource Book to the Michiana auction even though the original plan was to unveil it at the AGM. Dr. Palermo and Ms. Dumford expressed their support for sending the Resource Book to Michiana. Mr. Dumford commented that hearing about the demand for the KFPS book at a prior Michiana auction inspired, in part, the creation of the Resource Book.

Mr. Dumford reported an article for the next issue should be coming from breeding committee concerning clostridium. Kristy Dye Hedrick's veterinarian is preparing the article. Ms. Thwing said she could provide photographs if necessary.

Ms. Dumford said she talked to Nina Miller about the Friesians in entertainment article, but she did not obtain any photographs. Ms. Dumford proposed including in the article information about Wander's appearance in a movie and including a picture of Wander in an everyday setting not the movie.

Dr. Steehler said he has an article on stem cells ready for the next issue. Dr. Steehler also volunteered to write an article about the AGM for the next issue. The committee agreed that, if possible, the next issue should be held back so that an AGM article can be included.

Ms. Carpenter reported she is almost finished writing an article on an older woman who still rides and has seven geldings. Ms. Carpenter next wants to write an article about the woman's trainer who has "come to the dark side" and now wants to train only Friesians.

Ms. Carpenter also has the next installment of the Training a Foal to Drive series from Teresa Bron.

Ms. DePuydt reported she has (1) a finished article on Equine Estate Planning, (2) a half-page piece on research grants from the education committee, and (3) a possible article from the University of Kentucky concerning megaesophagus.



Ms. Thwing reported she is working on (1) an article comparing and contrasting dressage and saddle seat competition, (2) an article covering the Friesian presentations at the Michiana auction, and (3) an article demystifying the Amish and discussing the life of a horse with an Amish family.

The committee agreed that, because the next issue was going to be held for inclusion of the AGM coverage, another meeting would be useful before the next issue is completed.
