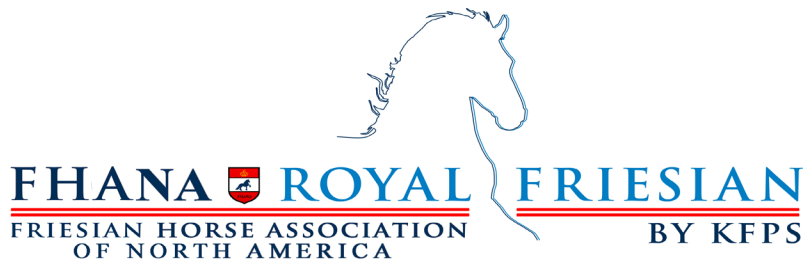


JANUARY 12, 2022
SITE HOST MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

ATTENDEES: LISA BAKER, ANNETTE CARPENTER, TIM ISBELL, MICHELLE SUMNER, SHARON BECHLER, JANICE VERMERRIS, BRENDA Abbamonte, MARIEKE, JASON TICE, TIFFANY VAN DER KOOI, AND JO CLOUGH

THE FOLLOWING TOPICS WERE DISCUSSED:

1. PANDEMIC PRECAUTIONS
 - a. GIVEN DIVERSE HEALTH REGULATIONS ACROSS THE UNITED STATES WITH RESPECT TO PREVENTION MEASURES TO STOP COVID, PARTICIPANTS WERE ADVISED TO REVIEW AND EMPLOY THEIR LOCAL HEALTH POLICIES.
 - b. MEMBERS WERE ASKED TO FOCUS THEIR EFFORTS ON ENSURING A SAFE ENVIRONMENT FOR ALL ATTENDEES. LOCAL JURISDICTIONS MAY REQUIRE MASKING, SOCIAL DISTANCING, AND THE LIKE.
2. THE ORDER OF GO: *IBOPS, MEASURING FOLLOWED CATEGORY 17, 1, 2, 3, 4, 15, 16, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14.*
 - a. A KFPS EXCEL SHEET WILL BE SENT TO SITE HOSTS THAT CONTAINS ALL OF THE INFORMATION THAT THE INSPECTION BOOKLETS HAS HISTORICALLY CONTAINED. THIS DOCUMENT ALSO LISTS THE HORSES IN THE ORDER OF GO TO HELP HOSTS WITH PLANNING.
 - b. THE FHANA OFFICE WILL MAKE 150 COPIES TO BRING TO THE MICHIANA INSPECTION BECAUSE OF THEIR SIZE. GIVEN THE SMALLER NUMBER AT THE OTHER SITES, WE REQUEST THEY PRINT THEIR OWN COPIES.
 - i. THE EXCEL DOCUMENTS CAN BE GIVEN OUT TO ATTENDEES AND POSTED FOR REFERENCE.
 - c. IT TAKES APPROXIMATELY 10 MINUTES PER HORSE FOR THE KFPS JUDGES TO COMPLETE THEIR ASSESSMENT FOR LINEAR SCORES. KNOWING THIS TIME WILL HELP HOSTS WITH ORGANIZING THE FLOW OF HORSES FOR EACH CATEGORY.
3. CHIP READER AND MEASURING
 - a. THE CHIP READER WILL BE SENT OUT TO THE FIRST INSPECTION SITE AND THE JUDGES WILL TAKE IT WITH THEM AS THEY TRAVEL SITE TO STIE. THE LAST SITE WILL SEND IT BACK TO THE FHANA OFFICE.
 - b. HOSTS SHOULD HAVE THEIR OWN EQUINE MEASURING STICK AVAILABLE FOR THE JUDGES TO USE.
4. NATIONAL ANTHEM
 - a. THE NATIONAL ANTHEM IS PLAYED BEFORE THE INSPECTION EVENT BEGINS.
5. CHAMPION CLASSES: FILLY, COLTS, YOUTH (INCLUDES CATEGORIES 3,4, 15, & 16), MARE, GELDING
 - a. UNVERIFIED HORSES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES
 - b. THERE IS A CHAMPION OF THE DAY/RESERVE CHAMPION OF THE DAY CLASS
 - i. TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE CHAMPION OF THE CLASS OR OF THE DAY, THE HORSE MUST BE AT LEAST A 2ND PREMIUM OR BETTER.



- c. IBOPS MUST HAVE A 77 OR BETTER TO BE AWARDED CHAMPION/RESERVE.
- d. AS OF 2020, THE RESULTS OF APTITUDE (IBOP) TESTS WILL BE ADDED TO THE HORSE'S PREDICATE IN THE FOLLOWING WAY:

73 through to 76.5: A
77 through to 81.5: AA
82 and higher: AAA

Inspection Manual Note - IBOP Cup (Iron Spring Farm Riding & Dream Gait Friesian Driving) There will be a champion and Reserve Champion Ribbon for both Ridden and Driven IBOPS. Only those horses that have a qualifying score of 77 or higher be considered for the Champion or Reserve Champion

6. TRIANGLE

- a. THE TRIANGLE SHOULD BE SET UP WITH WHITE POLY TAPE APPROXIMATELY 16" OFF THE GROUND SO THE HORSES CAN SEE IT AND TROT NEXT TO IT. PLANTERS CAN BE USED FOR THE SMALL TRIANGLE THE HORSES USE FOR WALKING.
- b. PLEASE REFER TO THE INSPECTION MANUAL FOR INSTRUCTIONS ON SET UP.

7. INSPECTION INFORMATION

- a. PLEASE ENSURE FOALS ARE COMFORTABLE IN HALTER IN ORDER TO SHOW THEIR BEST FOR THE WALK. FOALS ARE RELEASED FOR THE TROT.

8. ITEMS THAT THE FHANA OFFICE WILL SEND TO THE SITE

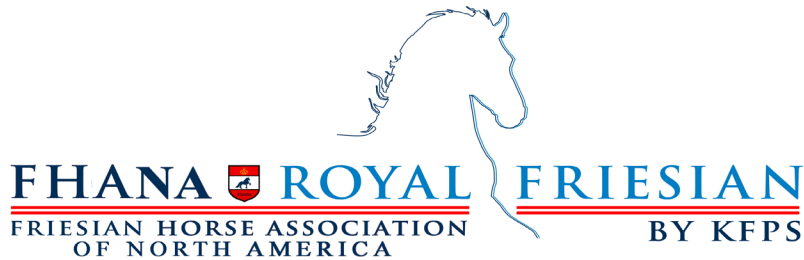
- a. BRIDLE TAGS
- b. CHIP READER
- c. SCRIBE SHEET FOR RESULTS

9. RIBBONS

- a. RIBBONS WILL BE SENT TO THE SITE HOSTS.
- b. THE BEST GUESS WAS MADE FOR ORDERING THE NUMBER OF ROYAL RIBBONS FOR EACH SITE.
- c. MICHIANA WILL HAVE AN ABUNDANCE OF RIBBONS GIVEN THEY EXPECT MORE THAN 80 HORSES.
- d. PLEASE NOTIFY THE OFFICE OF ANY SHORTAGES OR EXCESS OF RIBBONS.
- e. FOR THE WEST COAST IF YOU DO NOT USE ALL, SEND THE EXCESS DOWN TO THE NEXT SITE.

10. JUDGES TRAVEL, PLANNING IS ONGOING, SOME OF THE HIGHLIGHTS:

- a. THE KFPS NEEDS MORE TIME AND WILL FINALIZE PLANS AFTER THE STALLION SHOW IN THE NL.
- b. THE JUDGES ARE FLYING INTO SAN FRANCISCO AND THEY ARE RENTING THEIR OWN CAR. THEY WILL DROP OFF THE CAR AT THE AIRPORT,
- c. MICHIANA - THEY ARE FLYING INTO DETROIT AND LEAVE ON THE 13TH. IT IS A THREE HOUR TRIP FROM MICHIANA TO DETROIT SO THEY WILL STAY OVERNIGHT. THE EVENT LOCATION IS CLOSED ON SUNDAY.



11. JUDGES

- a. Piet Bergsma and Jolanda Slootjes WILL JUDGE.
 - i. DO NOT RELEASE THIS INFORMATION. DEPOSED.
- b. WE WILL PROVIDE INFORMATION TO HOSTS RELATING TO THE JUDGES DIETARY PREFERENCES.
- c. MEMBERS WERE CAUTIONED TO KEEP THE JUDGES SAFE IN SOCIAL SITUATIONS SUCH AS DINNERS OR MEET AND GREET EVENTS.

12. COGGINS TEST

- a. THESE ARE MANDATORY AND SHOULD BE KEPT AND REPORTED. IF NO COGGINS IS PRESENT THEN THE HORSE SHOULD NOT BE ALLOWED OFF THE TRAILER.
- b. Coggins and Foals – The BOD approved the recommendation to follow the USDA's Coggins testing requirement that nursing foals do not need a Coggins test prior to their inspection but weaned foals are required to be tested. The Coggins test must be valid based on the local authority of where the event venue is located.

13. ARENA RULES

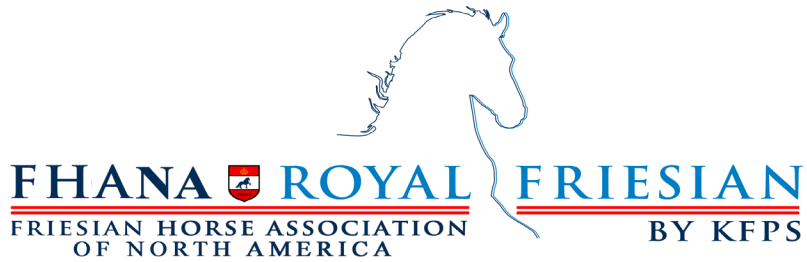
- a. KEEP PETS ON A LEASH, FOLLOW LOCAL ARENA RULES.
- b. Per the Inspection manual rules
 - i. No Spectators unofficial photographers or videographers may be in the arena at any time. -Event staff may be in the arena.
 - ii. Handlers/Trainers must wait outside of the arena unless presenting/running a horse.
 - iii. Owners may only enter the arena by invitation from the designated judge or judge's liaison.

14. Process changes for 2022

- i. Foals under six weeks are allowed to attend in 2022
- ii. One and two year olds can attend for free if registered in their birth year
- iii. More than one inspection is allowed in the 2022 calendar year, both results count
- iv. Reminder about eligibility requirements, eligibility table in the Inspection Manual
- v. Unverified foal process – new to sites
 1. Unverified Horses – The BOD approved a new process for dealing with unverified horses at inspections. *If a horse's identity cannot be verified by the officials at the inspection, the horse will be allowed to participate and receive comments in judging; however, the horse's results (premium and book) will be withheld. In addition, the horse will be disqualified from participating in any championship rounds. Once the DNA identity is confirmed the withheld results will be released in accordance with current FHANA policy.*

15. RUNNERS

- a. HOSTS WILL SHARE THEIR RUNNER RESOURCES WITH OTHER SITES TO DETERMINE IF THEY ARE WILLING TO COVER GAPS. THEY WILL EXPLORE IF EAST COAST RUNNERS WILL BE WILLING TO TRAVEL TO THE WEST.
- b. MICHIANA HAS LOCAL RUNNERS. THEY WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO ATTEND OTHER SITES DUE TO THEIR OWN TRAVEL LIMITATIONS



16. QUESTION – IF A HORSE IS NOT DOING WELL WITH THE WALK ASSESSMENT, CAN THE OWNER EXCUSE THEMSELVES AND PULL THE HORSE FROM JUDGING AT THAT TIME AND TAKE THE HORSE TO ANOTHER INSPECTION TO COMPLETE THE ASSESSMENT FOR THEIR LINEAR SCORE?
- a. HORSES CAN BE JUDGED TWICE IN 2022 AND BOTH RESULTS WILL BE RECORDED. HOWEVER, WE WILL CHECK WITH THE KFPS ON HOW THIS WOULD WORK WITH RESPECT TO LINEAR SCORES.
